

How can you help those in need in Haiti?



Starting January 14th through January 29th we are collecting items for the International Services of Hope (ISOH) to be shipped to Haiti. We are serving as a drop off spot at our offices located in Fremont, Port Clinton, Whitehouse and Elmore. The requested items are listed below:

In a sealed one gallon plastic bag:

- 1 hand towel (15"x25" up to 17"x27", no kitchen towels)
- 1 washcloth
- 1 comb (large and sturdy, not pocket sized)
- 1 nail file or fingernail clippers (no emery boards or toenail clippers)
- 1 bath-size bar of soap (3oz and up)
- 1 toothbrush (single brushes only in original wrapper, No child sized brushes)
- 6 adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages
- 1 tube of toothpaste

Please put these items in a separate Ziploc bag:

- Children's Tylenol
- Neosporin

Other items needed by ISOH (founded in 1991):

- Bottled Water, Canned Food, Rice, Beans, Non-Perishable Food items, manual can openers
- First Aid Kits, Personal Hygiene Items
- Flashlights, Batteries, Large Trash Bags
- Diapers, Wipes and Baby Care Items
- Rubber Gloves, Masks, Paper Towels, Toilet Paper, 5 Gallon Buckets with Lids
- Tents, Tarps, Ropes, Duct Tape, Bleach, Laundry Detergent
- Brooms, Dust Pans, Mops, mop heads, Cots and new blankets
- Sponges, Scrubbing Pads, Cleaning Towels, Spray and Liquid Cleaners (409, Pine Sol, etc)
